(* more than one answer may be correct on some)

1. Upon entering the field before the game, the crew notices that one set of uprights is slanted inward and the other is slanted outward. The crew should,

- a. Inform the coaches that the ruling official will ascertain whether any kick would be good assuming the uprights were straight
- b. Inform the coaches that we will play as they are**
- c. Inform game management they will need to attach a rope to each goalpost so that when we have a FG/try attempt, authorized personnel can 'pull' on the rope until they are straight
- d. Award 4 pts for a FG on the slant inward one, and only 2 pts on the slant outward one

2. It is specifically listed in the CVFOA Mechanics Manual that the HL & LJ shall communicate the # of players on the LOS by using an extended arm for 3, a fist on the chest for 2, and a fist on the chest with other hand on the elbow for 4.
