1. T The batting of a pass, kick or fumble in flight is not considered a new force for judging whether a touchback or safety results. Rule Ref: **2-13-3 8-5-1**
2. F A team "A" offensive player is a back if his head breaks the plane of an imaginary line drawn parallel to the line of scrimmage through the waistline of the nearest teammate who is legally on his line. Rule Ref: **2-30-3 7-2-3**
3. T One of the requirements for being on the offensive line is that the lineman's head or foot must break an imaginary plane drawn parallel to the line of scrimmage through the waistline of the snapper when the ball is snapped. Rule Ref: **2-30-9 2-24-2**
4. T A ball becomes live when the ball has been legally snapped or free kicked and a down is in progress. Rule Ref: **2-1-2**
5. T Force is the result of energy exerted by a player that provides movement of the ball. Rule Ref: **2-13-1**
6. F Post-scrimmage kick enforcement procedure applies to all kicking situations. Rule Ref: **2-16-2g**
7. F A1 and B1 may legally block in the back while the ball is in the free blocking zone and both players were on their line of scrimmage at the snap. Rule Ref: **2-17-4**
8. T All unsportsmanlike fouls are penalized from the succeeding spot. Rule Ref: **2-16-2c 2-40-9 10-4-4a**
9. F In order to utilize the post-scrimmage kick enforcement procedure, a foul by R must occur on K's side of the line of scrimmage. Rule Ref: **2-16-2g**
10. T When a defensive player uses a hand or arm, the hand must be in advance of the elbow at the time of contact. Rule Ref: **2-3-2b**
11. T Batting is an intentional act. Rule Ref: **2-2**
12. F A foul automatically causes the ball to become dead. Rule Ref: **2-16-4 4-2**
13. T A block in the back is defined as a block with contact inside of the shoulders, below the helmet and above the waist. Rule Ref: **2-5-2**
14. T During an authorized time-out held within 5 yards of the sideline, any number of team members may be involved. Rule Ref: **2-6-2a**
15. T A fair catch signal given by a receiver in his own end zone is not a foul. Rule Ref: **2-9-5**
16. T Loss of down is the loss of the right to repeat a down. Rule Ref: **2-7-2**
17. T When a ball is loose, it is in the possession of the team of the player who was last in possession. Rule Ref: **2-32-2 Fundamental 3**
18. F Any player in the free blocking zone at the time of the snap may block below the waist. Rule Ref: **2-17-2**
