1. A10's forward progress is stopped, but he continues to struggle despite repeated blasts of the whistle by the covering official.
 - a) Legal play, give him full forward progress
 - b) Delay, 5 yards from previous spot
 - c) Delay, 5 yards from the end of the run
 - d) Check your pea & buy a Big Bertha Acme Thunderer

2. With 0:12 on the clock in the 2nd quarter, QB A14 completes a pass to A82 at the B20 yd line. The ball is properly spotted and the "R" marks the it "ready for play" & signals the clock to start. In the rush & confusion to stop the clock, snapper A56 & QB A14 are the only "A" players in legal position when the ball is snapped and legally "spiked" by A14. A foul for an illegal formation occurs at the snap.
 - a) Multiple foul by A. Illegal formation, & spiking. B has the option
 - b) Foul for illegal formation only. 5 yards & clock starts on the ready
 - c) Foul for illegal formation only. 5 yards & clock starts on the snap
 - d) Foul(s) are declined, start clock on the snap
 - e) If the ball was "Spiked" did it hurt Glen Tuck?

3. 4th & 40 from the A 10 yd line, A26 runs to the A44 where he is downed. During the down substitute B69 enters the field, but does not contact anyone & does not influence the play.
 - a) Legal play
 - b) Non Player unsportsmanlike foul 15 yds tacked onto the run 1st & 10 for A @ B 41
 - c) Non Player unsportsmanlike foul dead ball 1st & 10 for B @ the B41
 - d) Non player foul penalize as dead ball. B's ball 1st & 10 @ A 49
 - e) No Harm – No Foul

4. K28's scrimmage kick is blocked at the K 5 yd line & is rolling away from the nearer goal line when R33 muffs the ball into K's end zone. K24 recovers & attempts to advance, but is downed in the end zone. During K24's run (a) R66 holds K14 in the EZ or (b) K14 holds R66 in the EZ.

 - b) Safety in A & B
 - c) Touchback in A basic spot 20 yd line
 - d) Safety in B only
 - e) Why can't the wing man make up his mind as to who held who, offset the flag

5. During the waning seconds of the game, a fight erupts & players from each team are ejected. After the SWAT team leaves the field and order is restored it is discovered Team A has only 11 players available & team B has 10. "What would you do, what would you do!!!"
