INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAKING THE 2009 RULES TEST

The Rules Test Questions are posted by position on our web site at www.CVFOA.org. The 2009 Rules Test has been changed from last years in one significant way. This year's test 1) only requires you to answer the questions as True or False; 2) supply the appropriate Rule Reference(s) from the 2008 (LAST YEARS) Rule/Case Book. Because the preparation of this test took place prior to the 2009 Rules Books being sent out we will be using the 2008 Rules. If there is a conflict in any test question between the 2008 and 2009 rules changes, credit will be given if appropriate.

You have selected the test for your preferred position of **Line Judge**. Complete the test and submit it to Kirk Bailey or Charlie Long, your Class Leaders, on or before the September 15, 2009 scheduled class. Your answers can be submitted to him via email or regular mail any time prior to this meeting date, if you prefer; the sooner you complete and submit the test the better.

Taking the test is simple. Read the question, locate the answer from the appropriate section in your "2008" Rule Book and answer True or False. Then record the Rule Number and Section Number/Letter (as needed) on the line noted "Rules Reference that supports your answer". NOTHING ELSE IS REQUIRED in the way of explanation.

If you answer the question correctly (T/F) "AND" note the correct rules reference, your answer is CORRECT. If "EITHER" of these items is wrong or missing then your answer is INCORRECT. Sample question:

No Player shall fight.

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If your test is not submitted by the September 15th date your true score will be reduced by 5 points.

If you are not satisfied with your grade you may resubmit once within 2 weeks from the date it is returned to you with corrected answers and your grade will be adjusted to the highest score you receive.

If you do not submit answers by the end of the September 15th meeting your grade will be zero.

The test is made up of the first 35 questions directly specific to the field position selected at 2 points per question (70 points). Also, there are the last 30 additional questions directly specific to the remaining four positions at 1 point per question (30 points). A total of 100 possible points.

2009 LINE JUDGE RULES TEST QUESTIONS

1) K 1 is attempting a field goal or try. His kick has a low trajectory and it strikes the back of K2, who is about a yard behind the neutral zone, but caroms forward and passes between the uprights and above the crossbar. Kick is Not Good. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
2) When a backward pass strikes the ground it becomes dead. True False
3) K1's punt, field goal attempt or free kick is muffed by R1 on his 5 yd.line. The ball rolls into team R's end zone and is recovered thereby K7. Touchdown. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
4) In a scrimmage kick formation, the snapper has special protection only until the ball has clearly been released in a legal snap. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
5) It is an unsportsmanlike foul if a disqualified A1 re-enters to participate. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
6) Kicking into a strong wind, K1's attempted FG is between the uprights. The ball breaks the invisible plane over the crossbar but is then blown back and lands in the end zone. 3 Points for K. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
7) If a loose ball touches a game official, who is straddling the sideline, the ball is not out of bounds. TRUE FALSE Rules reference (s) that support your answer
8) A guideline for the officials to follow in determining if a player is apparently unconscious is when the player is unable to receive information and/or unable to respond to questions or the player's responses are inappropriate. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
9) When a team commits two or more live ball fouls, including unsportsmanlike fouls, it's a multiple foul. TRUE FALSE Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
10) During a try, K1's place kick hits lineman K2 who is behind the neutral zone, and caroms between the uprights and above the crossbar. The ball is dead, B's ball 1st and 10 on B's 20 yard line. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
11) The basic spot is a point of reference for penalty enforcement: TRUE FALSE Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
12) On 4th and goal from the 5-yard line, the ball is marked ready for play with the nose of the ball just touching the 5-yard line. Following A1'sincomplete pass the ball is placed with the nose of the ball just touching the 5-yard line at the same spot that the ball was snapped, B will gain the length of the ball. 16) A's lineman take their positions and snapper A1 has made preliminary adjustments. Prior to the snap A1 lifts the ball and pushes it forward in order to make a deep snap. This is a legal adjustment. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:

17) Snapper A1 is positioned over the ball following the ready for play signal with but has not placed his hand(s) on the ball. A1 has a hand on the ground, then stands erect to call out a blocking assignment. Legal. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
18) It is a touchback if A1's fumble on B's 5 yard line is recovered by B1 in B's end zone. TRUEFALSERules Reference(s) that supports your answer
19) Team A comes to the line of scrimmage with: ends 80 and 71, tackles 70 and 81, guards 60 and 61 and center 50. A's gains 10 yards. Legal formation with end 71 and tackle 81 being ineligible receivers. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
20) R may recover any scrimmage kick anywhere between the goal lines & advance the ball. TRUE FALSE Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
21) With the clock winding down to end the game, the clock is stopped for a 1 _{st} down. The scoreboard clock shows 0:00 but the horn didn't sound. The game is over. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer

23) A1 advances beyond the LOS and throws an incomplete forward pass. Clock starts on the Ready. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
24) 4th and 10 on K's 30 yard line. K3 is the blocking back between the snapper and the punter K1. The ball is snapped to K3 who throws a backward pass to K1 who punts the ball. If K1 is contacted before he has had a chance to regain his balance or participate in the play, he is not afforded the same kicker protection as if the ball had been directly snapped to him. 25) A punt is a legal kick made while the ball is in a fixed position on the ground. TRUE FALSE Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:

29) K's scrimmage kick or a field goals attempt on 1 _{st} , 2 _{nd} , or 3 _{rd} down is blocked and remains behind the neutral zone and is recovered by a prone K player. K's ball where recovered. True False False
30) A period shall not be extended when a foul occurs that specifies a loss of down and the penalty is accepted. TRUE FALSE Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer:
31) 1 _{st} and 10 from A's 30. A1 takes the snap and throws a backward pass to A7 who is at A's 25. The ball bounces off his chest and hits the ground at A's 32 and rolls to a stop and comes to rest. Since the ball hit the ground beyond the LOS, this is an incomplete forward pass. 32) The pylons on the inbounds lines (hash marks) along the end line are three feet off the end line, and may be red, orange or yellow in color. When properly placed, the goal line pylon is inbounds. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer

33) During a measurement of a possible first down, all 11 players of team A wish to confer with their head coach (a) on the field within a huddle, or (b) within about nine yards of the sideline near their team's bench. Legal in a and b. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer

51) B2 gives a fair catch signal on B 40, but B 3 catches the ball at the B35 and is immediately tackled by A. Legal Play by A. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
52) The ball become dead when any loose ball is simultaneously caught by players on the same team. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
53) Any act that is clearly intended to cause B to encroach is an unsportsmanlike foul. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
54) A Kickoff hits one of the deep players for R and then caroms back to the K 5 where it is recovered by K who runs for a touchdown. Score for K. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
55) When a live ball becomes dead in player possession in that player's end zone, it is always a safety. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
56) A free kick may be made after a fair catch. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
57) 1st & 10 at the A40. Prior to the snap, B1 shows a blitz and A1 flinches. Encroachment. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
58) 1 st & 10 at the A 40. Prior to the snap, B 1 shows blitz and enters the neutral zone and then retreats before the snap. Encroachment True False Start Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
59) A's linemen go into a three point stance and back A1 goes in motion simultaneously. Illegal Procedure. True False Rules Reference (s) that supports your answer
60) During an authorized time out held within 5 yards of the sideline only 2 coaches may participate. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
61) A player is in the free blocking zone when any part of his body is in the zone at the snap. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
62) Try from the B3. Extra point kick is blocked. A 8 recovers behind LOS & advances into the end zone. Point is good. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
63) 1st & 10 at the 50yd. Just before the snap, A1 comes from the sideline onto the field to make the 11th A player. He sets just inside the sideline and is legally on the line of scrimmage. A3 runs to the B42. Legal Formation. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
64) Offensive interior linemen may advance beyond the neutral zone after the ball is in flight. True False Rules Reference(s) that supports your answer
