

KICKING QUIZ ANSWERS

1. Even though Milton does not think we should, the BJ will carry 2 beanbags this year. Look at the bright side Milton, more beanbag sales for you. On a, b, c, and d there is no beanbag because the end of the kick is simultaneous as the end of the down. Your spot would be the same spot as the beanbag, so why throw it.
2. There is no requirement as there is on scrimmage downs for players to be within 15 yards of the ball after the ready for play (7-2-1)
3. A little confusing, as the mechanics manual states for LJ “cover all kicks on your side”, “assist BJ ruling on fair catch signal”, yet it tells BJ they are responsible for ruling on fair catch. My answer, not that it matters, is the BJ is responsible for fair catch and the deep man, but he could get some help from the LJ.
4. 6-1-2 states that when a punt is used following a safety, the ball must be kicked within one step behind K’s free kick line, so neither kick is legal.
5. The ball is dead when the kickers touch a kick that has come to rest beyond the neutral zone. NO TD. 4-2-2f
6. The touching is ignored. 6-2-4. R’s ball on the 5.
7. R2 is deemed to have touched the ball, however, K7’s bat is first touching (beanbag) and team r may take the ball, 1st & 10 at that spot.
8. The LJ should bean bag the yard line of a recovery by K when the recovery is within a yard of the previous spot when holding position on the line. Then he should follow the play accordingly. In a) R’s ball at the 25 1st & 10, in b) K’s ball 1st & 10 at the 35.
9. This happened to us at a JV game last year. We did not have a clue, but someone has since said look at 4-3-6, where it says BEFORE the ready for play, A may designate the spot from which the ball is put in play anywhere between the inbounds lines: b) for a kickoff.
